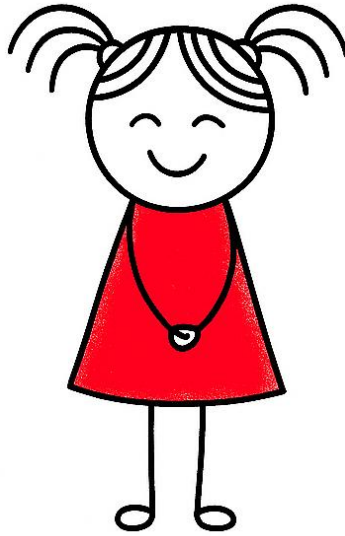




Ava
